**W**elcome back to The Portland & thank you for continuing to support small business, it is greatly appreciated!

As you know, Cambridge has been placed in tier 2. This means that we can only sell alcohol if food is ordered. The restrictions also include no mixed households at a table indoors; however mixed households to a maximum of 6 people are permitted in the beer garden.

As well as our standard menu, we are launching a special tier 2 menu which will be 2 or 3 courses for a set price. We have also extended our Buy 1 get 2<sup>nd</sup> for £1 burger deal to run all day. Both offers will be available Thursday – Saturday. With the current restrictions people are required to leave the pub when the meal experience is finished.

For those mixed household groups in the garden, we have charity blankets for sale, the blankets are £8 each and for you to take home with you, £5 from each blanket sale will be divided between Alzheimer's research and Cambridge food bank.

### **HOW TO ORDER**

You will need to place your food order with your first alcoholic drink, you are very welcome to have drinks before the food arrives as well as during your meal and it is reasonable to order a digestif for after your meal. To ensure that we are on the right side of the law we have implemented a procedure of one last drink order before your table is cleared. This enables you to enjoy a beverage after your meal but remain within the regulations as laid out. If you wanted to remain in the pub after your digestif, you are very welcome but unfortunately will only be permitted non alcoholic drinks from this point.

This certainly is not how we envisaged operating our business but safety and protecting the licence of the pub must be a priority.
